MRCB Joins Local Puchong Community for Anti Dengue Gotong Royong

Kuala Lumpur Sentral CBD, 15 March 2015 – Malaysian Resources Corporation Berhad (MRCB) together with the residents along Jalan Berkat in Kampung Sri Aman, Puchong, today held a gotong royong activity near MRCB's work site for the Ampang LRT Line Extension project. This activity is a part of MRCB's Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative to combat the dengue threat.

Members of about 30 households in Kampung Sri Aman along with MRCB's volunteers, subcontractors and local authorities set out early to begin work clearing up the areas along the LRT line extension worksite. The MRCB team was led by Datuk Dell Akbar Khan, the Group's Executive Vice President for Security, Safety, Health, & Environment, Facilities Management and Parking Services while LRT network asset owner and operator Prasarana Malaysia Berhad was represented by Dato' Ir. Zohari Sulaiman its Group Director for Project Development.

The clean-up gotong royong was aimed at ensuring that any potential breeding ground for mosquitoes, the Aedes species in particular, is cleared from debris and any potholes that could collect water. The Aedes mosquito or Aedes Aegypti breeds in places with clear stagnant water such as construction and abandoned work sites. The activity also aimed to enhance awareness among the local residents about the dangers of the disease, which seem to be on the rise recently.



About 120 people participated in the gotong royong that lasted until the early afternoon. They focused the clean-up activities along the alignment of the LRT extension line beginning from Pier 468 to Pier 488 where works are ongoing to deliver Package B (Construction of Facilities Works) for the Ampang LRT Line Extension that started in October 2011.

The project alignment begins from the existing Sri Petaling LRT Station and terminates at the Putra Heights Integrated Terminal, in an extension of about 10 km out of a 17.70 km total length of extension together with Package A of the project. MRCB was also appointed as the nominated subcontractor to fabricate and deliver segmental box girders under Package B of the Kelana Jaya LRT Line Extension.

In today's CSR gotong royong activity, MRCB was joined by its subcontractors Bina Puri Sdn Bhd and LM Partners Sdn Bhd, together with project management company Opus Group Berhad. They were supported by the Subang Jaya Municipal Council (MPSJ), the Puchong Fire and Rescue Department (Bomba), the Puchong Royal Malaysian Police (PDRM) and the Petaling Jaya Health District Office.
