MRCB Donates Soccer Balls to Schools in Brickfields & Three States

Kuala Lumpur Sentral CBD, 15 September 2015 – Malaysian Resources Corporation Berhad (MRCB) today donated 100 soccer balls to eight schools in Brickfields, out of a total 200 being donated, as part of its overall CSR-driven initiative for communities along Jalan Tun Sambanthan and Little India, as well as the whole of Brickfields.

For today's event, representatives of eight schools comprising Sekolah Kebangsaan La Salle 1 and Sekolah Kebangsaan La Salle 2; Sekolah Kebangsaan Brickfields 1 and Sekolah Kebangsaan Brickfields 2; Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan Tamil Vivekananda; Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan Cina St Teresa; Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan La Salle and Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Vivekananda were gathered at the Open Hall in Sekolah Kebangsaan La Salle 1 for a simple handing over event at this school, which is located in the Little India neighbourhood of Brickfields.

The gift of another 100 soccer balls from MRCB will be distributed to five other schools in three states. These schools are Sekolah Kebangsaan Serandu and Sekolah Kebangsaan Indera Shahbandar (Pahang); Sekolah Kebangsaan Kuala Perai and Sekolah Kebangsaan Pengkalan Jaya (Pulau Pinang) and Sekolah Kebangsaan Iskandar Perdana (Perak).

MRCB's Executive Vice President, Datuk Dell Akbar Khan, who spoke at the event in Little India said that similar CSR-driven events and initiatives have been held for the Brickfields community regardless of race, religion and age, ever since MRCB began to develop Kuala Lumpur Sentral.
