**MRCB & Datin Paduka Seri Rosmah handover Ramadhan hampers
and cash to 500 orphans and 150 single mothers at
Stesen Sentral Kuala Lumpur**

Kuala Lumpur Sentral CBD, 17 July 2014 – In a simple yet meaningful event that celebrated the spirit of giving in Ramadhan, a total of 500 orphans and 150 single mothers, together with 10 orphanages and 2 single mothers associations that represented their interests, received cash assistance from Malaysian Resources Corporation Berhad (MRCB).

At the event held at the Stesen Sentral Kuala Lumpur (SSKL) MRCB's guest of honour, YABhg. Datin Paduka Seri Rosmah Mansor, the Patron for PERMATA programmes presented cash and hampers to 500 orphans and another 150 single mothers. The hampers consist of basic food supplies like rice, flour, sugar, milk powder, cooking oil, toothpaste, drinks etc.

Representatives of 10 orphanages and 2 single mothers associations also received a cheque of RM5,000.00 for each organisation from YABhg. Datin Paduka Seri Rosmah Mansor. The single mothers association were Pertubuhan Ibu Tunggal Bandar Tun Razak and the Pertubuhan Ibu Tunggal Islam Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur & Selangor, while the orphanages comprise Rumah Titian Kaseh, Rumah Amal Cahaya Tengku Ampuan Rahimah (RACTAR), Pertubuhan Kebajikan Nur Syaheera Kuala Lumpur, Pertubuhan Rumah Anak Yatim Miskin Daerah Kuala Langat, Kompleks Anak Yatim Darul Kifayah, Pertubuhan Kebajikan Baitul Kasih Wilayah Persekutuan Dan Selangor, Pertubuhan Kebajikan Baitul Fiqh, Pusat Jagaan NURI, Pertubuhan Kebajikan Anak-Anak Yatim Al-Nasuha and Persatuan Rumah Perlindungan Hajah Kamariah.

Among the activities implemented include study visits, sponsoring of newspaper educational pullouts in classrooms, motivational workshop, smart learning programme, UPSR clinics and enhancement of understanding in Mathematics, English and Science subjects.

“As of 2014, the PINTAR programme has been running for 7 years for underprivileged and lower-performing students who have gained direct benefits from focused and specialized tutoring sessions from experienced former teachers and academicians.

This programme has shown good improvement, with the number of students getting straight As for UPSR on the increase every year. Up till 2013, MRCB has sponsored more than 15,000 primary school students involving RM3 million in sponsorship, since becoming a member of the PINTAR foundation in 2007," Tan Sri Azlan added.

In addition, MRCB has also contributed school items under its Young Leaders Campaign for over 12,000 students since 2002. The school items' contributions include school uniforms, school shoes and socks, school bags, stationery etc. MRCB also conducted other CSR activities like GEM and 1Malaysia Training Scheme for unemployed graduates. A significant amount was also spent on humanitarian and natural disaster relief in the eastern and northern parts of Peninsular Malaysia.
