RM812,000 Funds Raised for MH17 Cabin Crew & Palestinian Relief Fund at NU Sentral Squash Charity Match

Kuala Lumpur Sentral CBD, 23 August 2014 – As part of its programme as venue sponsor for the CIMB Malaysian Open Squash Championships 2014, the NU Sentral retail mall held a charity match to collectively raise funds for the family members and loved ones of the perished technical and cabin crew members onboard MH17 as well as for the Palestinian Relief Fund.

The charity squash match for MH17 fund-raising was held between Malaysian Resources Corporation Berhad's (MRCB) Group Managing Director, Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din and CIMB Investment Bank's Chief Executive Officer, Tengku Dato' Zafrul Tengku Abdul Aziz.

A minute of silence was observed in honour of those who perished on MH17 and victims of Gaza before the start of the match.

A total of RM812,000 was collected from donors that comprise MRCB's and CIMB's business partners, suppliers and contractors, many of whom were among the more than 2,000 spectators watching the match at the specially constructed squash court at NU Sentral's main concourse.

The amount collected was handed over to Malaysia Airlines and to Mercy Malaysia for the Palestinian Relief Fund.
